

Golf Cart Safety

- **Driver MUST have a valid drivers license to drive on public roads.**
- Keep feet, legs, hands and arms inside the vehicle at all times.
- One (1) occupant maximum per seat.
- Always remain seated and hold on while the vehicle is in motion.
- Avoid driving fast downhill. Sudden stops or change of direction may result in loss of control.
- Use the brake to control speed when traveling down an incline.
- Slow down before and during turns. All turns should be executed at reduced speed.
- Always check behind you when reversing.
- Use the parking brake whenever the vehicle is parked.
- Always turn the key to “off” when leaving the vehicle.
- Always yield to pedestrians, they have the right of way even on private property.
- Slow down to normal walking speed when around pedestrians.
- Always come to a complete stop at STOP signs.
- Obey all traffic laws and operate the vehicle responsibly.
- Do not block walkways and/or entrances.
- Make sure that the forward-neutral-reverse (f-n-r) lever is in neutral before starting the vehicle.
- Always bring the vehicle to a complete stop before shifting the f-n-r lever.
- Put the f-n-r lever to neutral when leaving the vehicle unattended.
- Always park on flat ground.
- Make sure that the vehicle is properly maintained (refer to golf cart operation and care & maintenance information).
